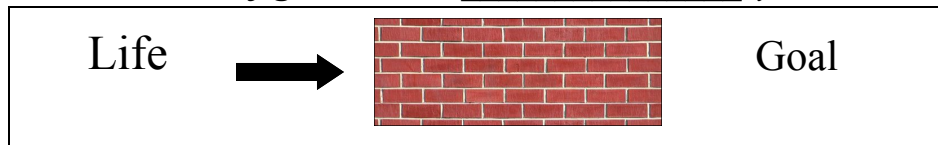


The Glue in Guilt

Questions of Jesus to Consider :

*Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they?
Has no one condemned you?"* John 8:10 (bold added)

Warning: Don't Let . . .

Others' Opinions **F**_____ **you.** {Not the Final Judge}

*Can any of you prove me guilty of sin? If I am telling the
truth, why don't you believe me?* John 8:46 (bold added)

Others **E**nable and **E**mpower you to find **F**_____.

*Accusation without **P**roof or **E**nergy without **T**ruth*

*Do you see a man wise in his own eyes? There is more hope for
a fool than for him.* Proverbs 26:12

*Do you see a man who speaks in haste? There is more hope for
a fool than for him.* Proverbs 29:20

*... I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone on the

Questions of Jesus to Consider :

*When they had finished eating, Jesus said to Simon Peter,
"Simon son of John, do you truly love me more than
these?" "Yes, Lord," he said, "you know that I love you."
Jesus said, "Feed my lambs." ¹⁶ Again Jesus said, "Simon
son of John, do you truly love me?" He answered, "Yes,
Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus said, "Take care of
my sheep." ¹⁷ The third time he said to him, "Simon son of
John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt because Jesus asked
him the third time, "**Do you love me?**" He said, "Lord, you
know all things; you know that I love you." Jesus said,
"Feed my sheep." John 21:15-17 (bold & underline added)*
