The **POWER** of **ONCE**

Jesus sacrificed and offered Himself out of L_____.

*Unlike the other high priests, He does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for His own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins **once for all** **when He offered Himself.** Hebrews 7:27 (bold and underline added)*

Jesus sacrificed and entered so it would L_____.

¹² *He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but He entered the Most Holy Place **once for all** **by His own blood**, having obtained **eternal redemption**.*

²² *In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.*

²⁶ *... But now He has appeared **once for all** at the end of the ages **to do away with sin** **by the sacrifice of Himself**. Hebrews 9:12, 22, 26 (bold and underline added)*

*If it could, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshipers would have been cleansed **once for all**, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins. And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ **once for all**.*

Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can **never take away sins**.
